Dear Parents:

Thanks so much for entrusting your child to our care on Sunday morning at the Christ United Methodist Church! We're looking forward to a terrific year of fun and learning as we study the Bible together in lots of interesting ways.

Sunday school meets each Sunday at 10:45 am in the Church Basement. Following is the daily Sunday School Agenda

10:45 - 11:00: Snack Time

11:00 - 11:15: Games

11:15 - 11:30: Devotion/Worship

11:30 - 12:15: Lesson/Wrap Up

Sunday school affirms the home as the center of biblical guidance. Parents are the most important people in a child's life, and learning about God starts in the home. Teaching children about God is a seven-day-a-week effort, not something that can be done just an hour or two on Sunday morning. We pledge to do our best to support you in your child's spiritual education, and stand ready to help you at any time.

Bring Bible and Offering

Please encourage your child to bring a Bible and an offering each week. We will actively use the Bible each Sunday in class. The Sunday school offerings will be used for Sunday school trips as well as mission offerings. However, we also use the children's offering to help them develop good habits of stewardship.

Encourage Regular Attendance

Sunday school starts each week at 10:45 a.m. Please help your child to be on time and attend as often as possible. We prepare carefully each week to begin meaningful teaching from the very beginning of the class, and your child's arrival on time helps the whole class to get the most out of the session.

Pray

We promise to join you in praying for you and your child. We believe that prayer is an effective and powerful force to help protect your child and help him develop to his highest spiritual potential. We would much appreciate your prayers for us and the class as well.

In addition, we encourage your child to develop the habit of a daily quiet time with God, which will help provide a firm foundation for his/her future life.

Cellphone Policy

Cellphone is NOT allowed in Sunday school. When your child enters Sunday school, he/she will be asked to place their cellphones in the "Cellphone Basket" which will be put away for the duration of the lesson. Your child can pick up their cellphones after Sunday school is over. Please work with your child to make sure they comply with this policy.

Snacks/Birthday Celebrations

We have a snack time during Sunday school each week. We also celebrate Birthdays once a month. If you would like to sponsor the snacks during a regular Sunday school week or during your child's Birthday you are welcome to do so, however please let us know ahead of time so that we can plan accordingly.
